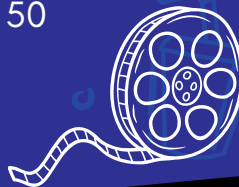
# COMMS ON THE BIG SCREEN

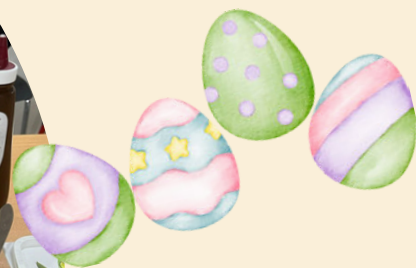




# Egg-cited for Easter
